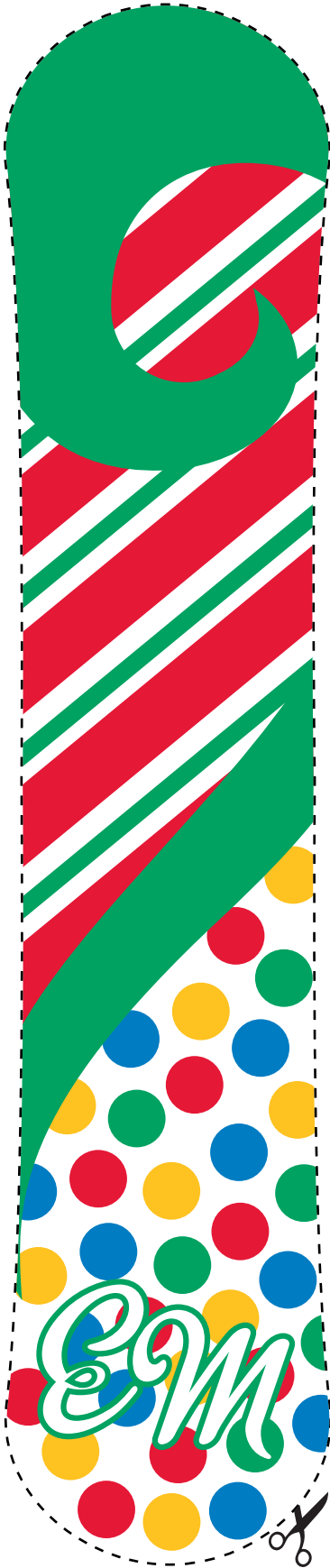


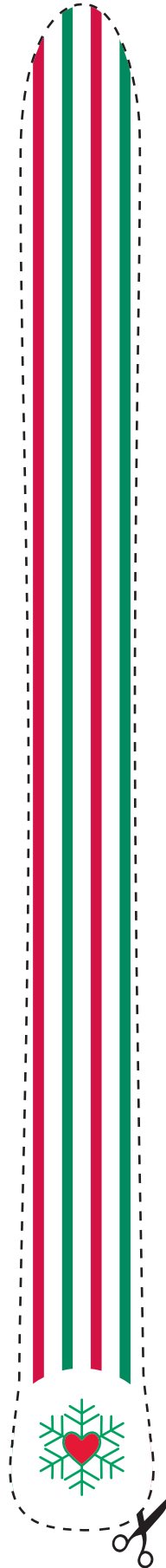

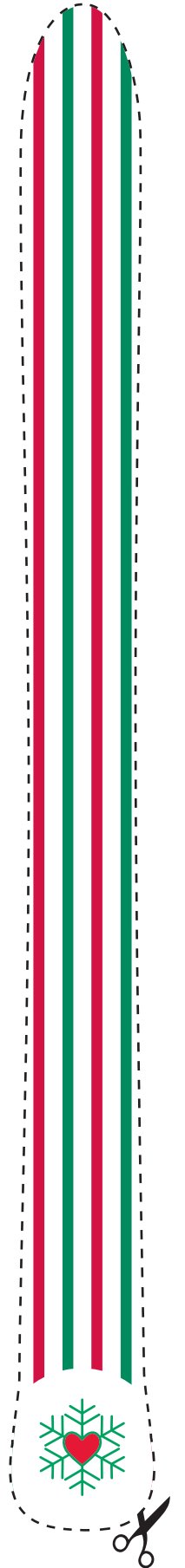
Snowboard Design 1

Elf Magic Snowboards and Skis Instructions

(Requires Adult Supervision)

Materials:

- Scissors/sharp cutting blade craft knife
- 8 ½ X 11-inch sheet of heavy card stock paper and glue or 8 ½ X 11-inch full sheet label paper
- Cardboard, balsa wood, or foam core
- Rubber bands or pipe cleaners

Instructions:

Option 1:

1. Print Elf Magic Snowboards and Skis on heavy card stock paper.
2. Cut along the dotted lines with scissors.

Option 2:

To make the Snowboards and Skis more “durable”

1. Print Snowboards and Skis on card stock/regular copy paper or print on a whole sheet of white label paper.
2. For a base, use 8 ½ X 11 cardboard, balsa wood, foam core, “Durastiff” or “Durafelt”
3. Adhere the rest of the printed paper with glue or peel off the back of label paper and place on the product you have chosen to use as your base.
4. Using scissors or cutting blade craft knife, cut the pieces out by following the dotted lines.
(Important; adult supervision is essential. Children should not use scissors or cutting devices without adult supervision at all times.)
5. Use rubber bands or pipe cleaners to attach the snowboards and skis to the elf’s “Arctic Play” Snow Boot.

Note: If you don't have a color printer, then you can print and color the black and white copy.
